Dear David,

Thank you for your email on Friday. I am sighted on a subsequent email sent on Friday afternoon by JAH to my own specially selective group of senior officers in SYP. At the time of writing my own two emails to you last Friday, I was unaware that it was JAH's intention to also write to you personally the very same day. Anyway, I hope over the weekend, you and some of your senior officers got some opportunity to reflect on the contents and advice contained within JAH's important message. I hope His message is received in the spirit of genuine concern in which it was sent. Personally, I think we both sense that SYP are moving into a very challenging and interesting period. You are at a crossroads. If you are to successfully steer and transform your police force, you will indeed need very special help. On the other hand, if your efforts are not that genuine, then you may not relish seeing some of the film footage, as parts may not be very edifying for you, given that, and to coin a phrase of yours, our viewpoints differ on some key issues.
